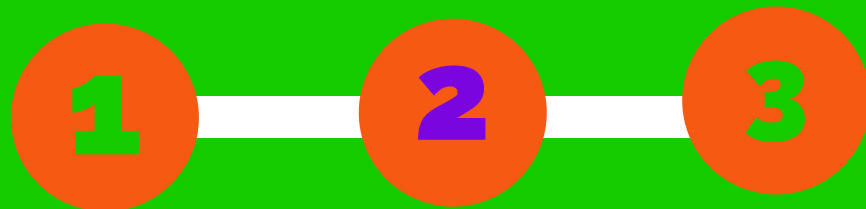




THE CLEANING SAFE RULE OF 3

Clean FIRST then "ZAP". Before you disinfect a surface be sure to clean away dirt and grime with an all-purpose cleaner., **then** disinfect.

Spray & Stay - don't spray and wipe. Follow the directions on the back of the disinfectant bottle for dwell time.

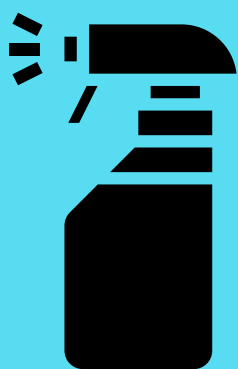

Once-N-Done - if using a sanitizing wipe, by the 3rd door knob you're doing more harm than good. Wipe once and toss, or flip to a clean side when using cotton or microfiber towels.

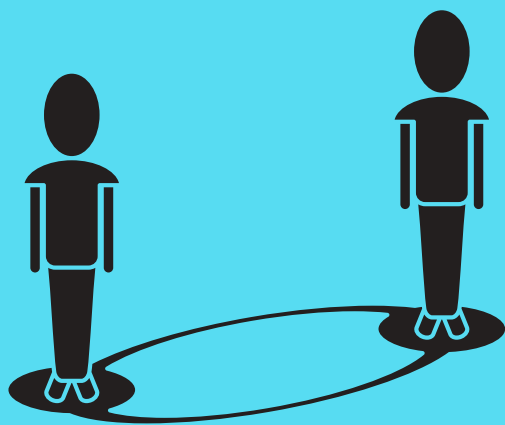


1.) NOW, WE CARRY DISINFECTANT

2.) OUR EMPLOYEES WASH THEIR HANDS FIRST

Upon entering your home our employees will wash their hands with soap and water before starting to work and at the completion of the job.

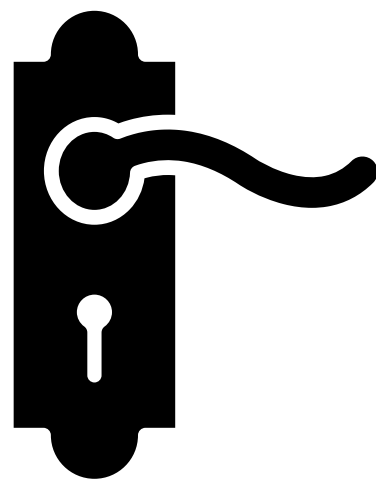


3.) SOCIAL DISTANCING

For your protection and ours we ask each customer to move from room to room as we clean in order to maintain a six foot distance at all times.

4.) WE'VE ADDED CLEANING OF HIGH-TOUCH AREAS

At no extra charge, we will clean light switch plates, door knobs, alarm panels, the garage button, cabinet pulls and knobs, toilet flush handles, and more with disinfecting spray.



5.) WE'RE SANITIZING OUR EQUIPMENT BETWEEN JOBS
